

Matching "what's needed" with "what's possible" for the use of technology in care.....








#### The TAPPI mechanics.....

  - Smart Homes and Independent Living Commission (APPG on AT) 2021






## Personal Perspectives......

Processes can easily be siloed & collaboration is difficult.....


Simple **Principles** can be part of every conversation about technology & care
