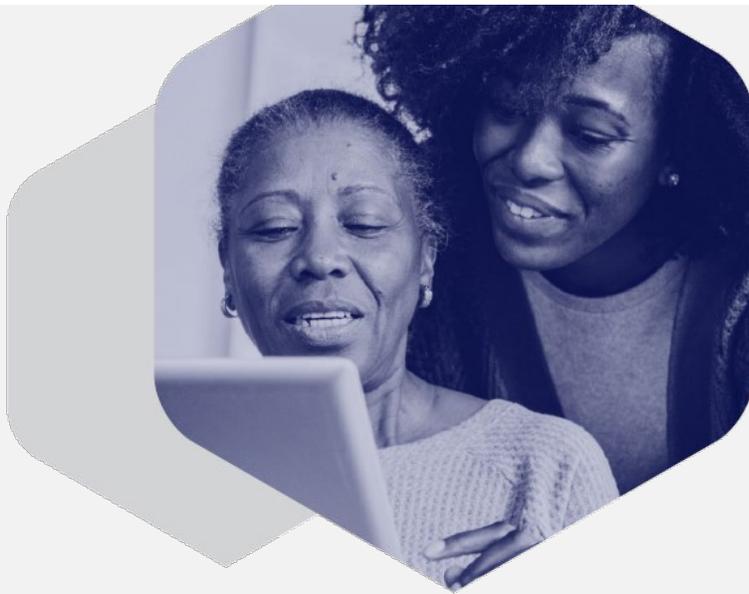

We are the trusted voice and source of knowledge to enhance the understanding, development and adoption of technology in care.

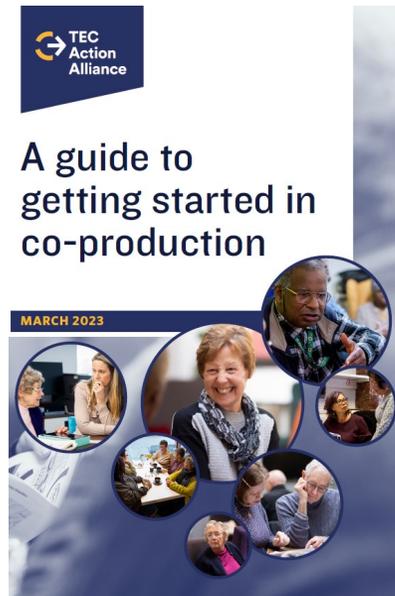

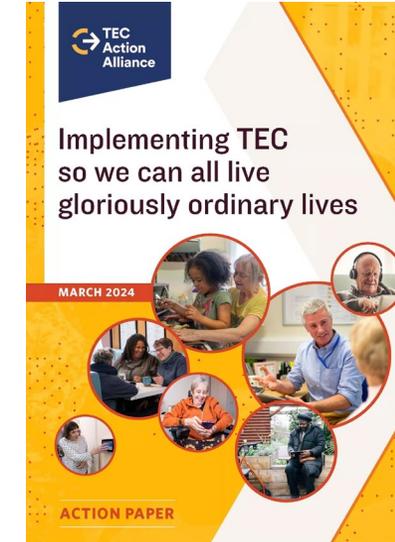

Workforce understanding stops TEC priorities

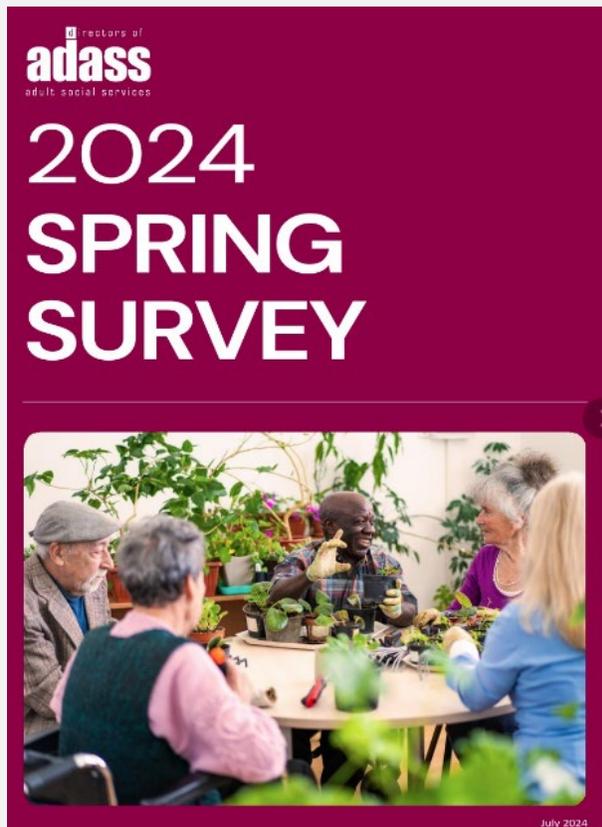

An opportunity for TEC: NHS Reform

TEC is Key to the Government Agenda

Prime Minister Sir Kier Starmer has promised:

“the biggest re-imagining of our NHS since its birth”

Outlining three big shifts for the NHS:

- 1. Moving care from hospitals to the community*
- 2. Shifting services from analogue to digital*
- 3. Moving away from treating sickness to prevention*

He also declared that the Government’s 10-year plan for the NHS will ‘have the fingerprints of NHS staff and patients all over it.’
