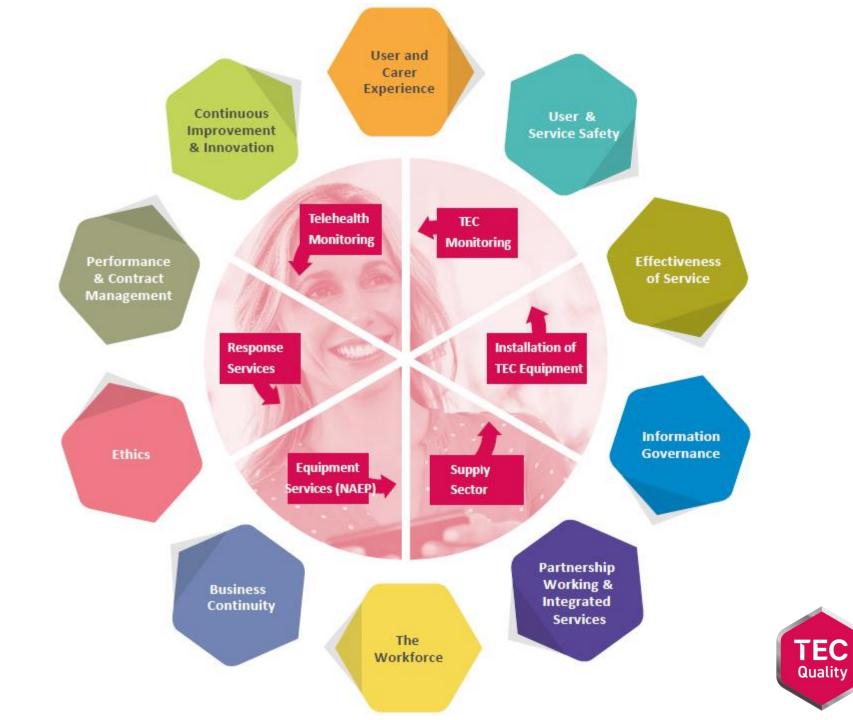

Social alarm systems

Part 1: Design, installation and maintenance of social alarm systems in specialized grouped living environments – Code of practice

"a preventative maintenance programme should be undertaken at intervals of not less than once every 12 months, or more frequently if advised by the manufacturer".

> The maintainer should, where possible, correct any faults during the maintenance visit.

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Focus on Dispersed Alarm Equipment, but carries the same preventive maintenance message.





Landlords have legal obligation to conduct gas safety checks. During the pandemic, landlords should assess the balance of the risk to the safety

TEC should also be considered as a Safety Critical Service.
