Who's problem is it?






Cost of 1 x 15 minute medication visit costs £8,400 – South Tyneside Council



Why Every Dose Matters

- Drug concentration in the blood needs to be kept within a therapeutic range
 - − Too high \rightarrow Can cause adverse effects
 - Too low → Patient will not receive therapeutic benefit of drug
 - This can happen if the patient takes the drug at irregular intervals, or takes the incorrect dose
- YOURmeds Solution supports and monitors patients taking their medication in Real Time
 - Ensuring the patient receives the benefits of the drug without any adverse effects



Parkinson's & Neuro Referrals


- Improve medication compliance and adherence
- Service users are on a standard blister pack
- Joint programme between Manchester City Council Assistive Technology Team and Manchester Local Care Organisation
- Working with Parkinson and Neurological Team Nurses to identify patients
- Patients are on average of 6 medication rounds a day
- YOURmeds works on a sequential basis using multiple tags




"I like the smart blister pack because it lets me know when to take my medication as my memory isn't always the best.
