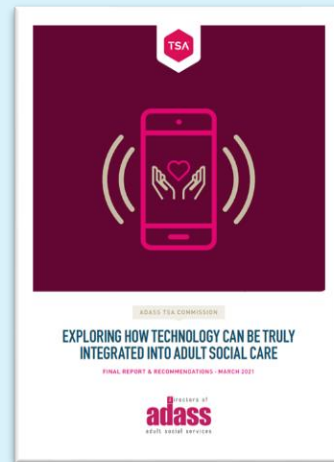

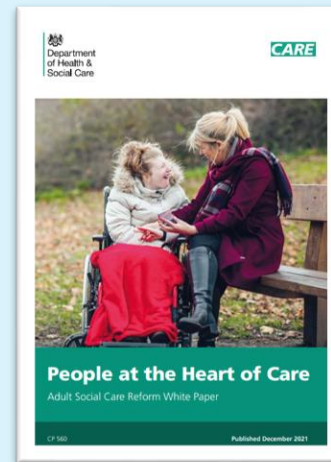

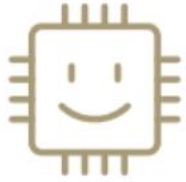

More collaboration is needed in care and support across all levels, so services and policies are joined-up and contribute to the wider wellbeing of people, their families and carers.

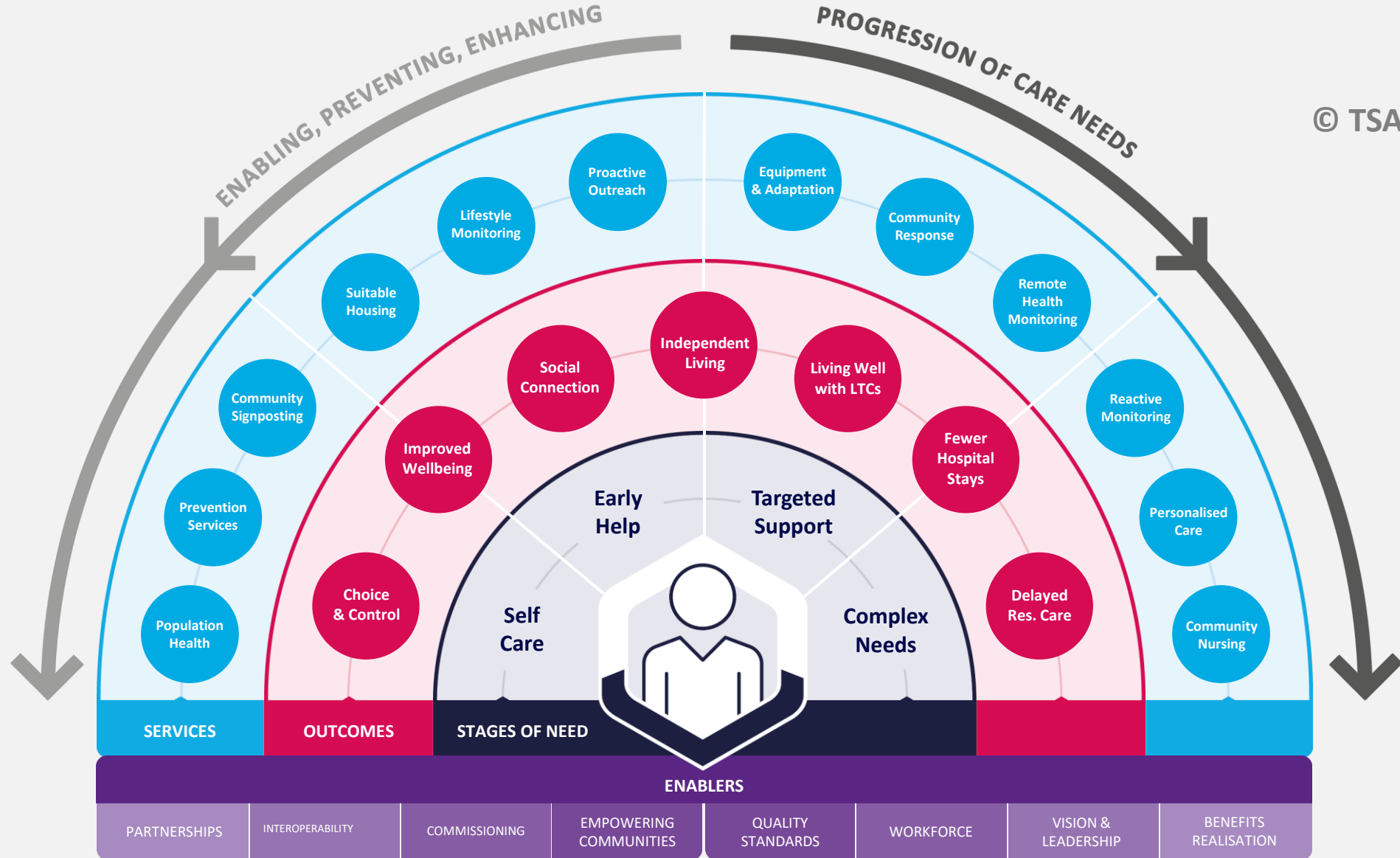

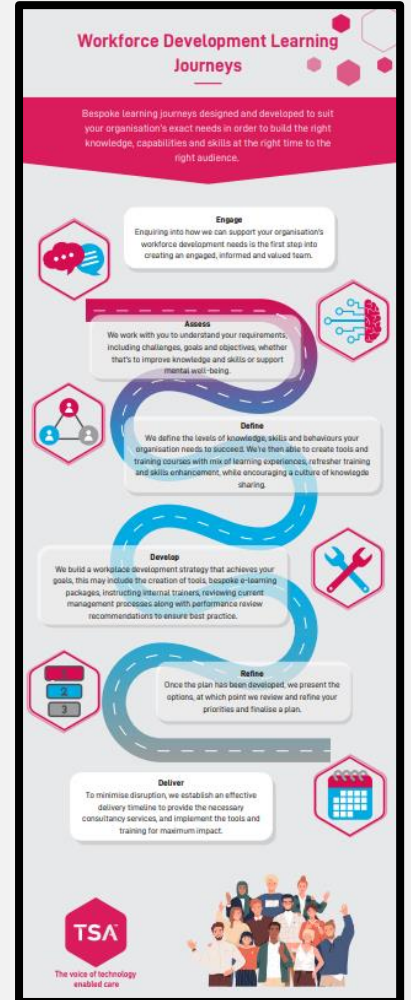
